Board of Control Update

The MPSSAA Board of Control held its annual winter meeting on December 6, 2012. The following are highlights from the meeting.

- * Approved the 2013 Spring Bulletins.
- * Accepted the 2012 spring and fall financial report, 2012 fall sports' reports and the 2012-13 winter sports' updates.
- * Updated on the Heat Acclimatization process including the results on the survey for next steps.
- * Approved Classifications with sectional alignments for the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons. Classifications can be found on pages 3 and 4 of this edition of Scout.

Heat Acclimitization

Last year, the Maryland General Assembly enacted legislation requiring each local school system to adopt a model policy designed to acclimatize student-athletes to participate effectively in warm and hot conditions and reduce the risk of heat related illnesses. These guidelines took effect immediately and impacted traditional practice plans this past fall sports pre-season.

In an attempt to strike a safe balance between a gradual introduction and assimilation into athletic competition with the need to properly teach safe playing techniques, the MPSSAA conducted a survey of Athletic Administrators regarding ways to increase instruction time prior to the first date of competition while not compromising a student-athlete's acclimatization period. Results from that survey can be found on pages 5 and 6 of this edition of Scout. The MPSSAA Executive Council will use the the survey results as well as other input in determining the next steps.

Region Meet Procedures For Indoor Track

The State Indoor Track & Field Committee needs results from all regular season meets to verify entries into the region meets. All entries MUST be verifiable performances from the current season. A performance is considered verifiable if it is posted on the results listing (mpssaa.org) by the deadline of 2/1/13. To have results posted, they must be sent via email to Gerard Filosa at mdstatetrackmeet@gmail.com. Be sure to go to www.mpssaa.org for information including a results listing.

The MPSSAA will host the boys and girls' basketball tournament draw on Feb. 17, 2013. The draw will be held at Long Reach High School. Coaches are reminded that the tournament will allow the top four teams in each region to be seeded based on their regular-season win-loss record (excluding holiday tournaments). The remaining teams in each region will be placed on the bracket by a blind draw. Region directors must verify and submit to the state committee on the morning of the draw the official records of each of their region's teams through Saturday, Feb. 16.
