REMINDERS:

- 1. Directions to the golf course are available on the internet at www.classic5golf.com and click on "Forest Park".
- 2. The parking lot is across the street from the clubhouse. There will be assistants available to drive you and your clubs across the street to the clubhouse for checkin.
- 3. Please be prepared for the prevailing weather conditions forecast for the day.
- 4. Proper golf attire is required as are soft spike golf shoes or regular tennis shoes.
- 5. Please plan to arrive at least 30 minutes prior to the start of your event in order to check-in and get any last minute instructions. The clinic begins promptly at 2 PM and the tournament play begins with a shotgun start at 1 PM sharp.
- 6. Players participating in the 18-hole and the 9-hole events are expected to carry their clubs and bags per USGA and MPSSAA rules. Clinic participants are reminded to bring their own clubs to use for full swing, pitching, chipping, and putting drills.
- 7. Some of the yardages have been adjusted for this event and therefore play for each hole will be from the white tee markers that say "Championship Flight" for the 18-hole group and from the red tee markers that say "9-Hole Tournament" for the 9-hole group.
- 8. Additional local rules to govern play (if any) the day of the event will be provided to you on Saturday.
- 9. Forest Park does NOT have a driving range but they do have one putting green in back of the clubhouse that you may use.
- 10. Forest Park does have a snack bar for food and beverage purchases and a pro shop for any last minute equipment needs.
- 11. Carts will be available for use by event supervisors and scorekeepers. Spectators and coaches not assigned to supervise a group can rent carts for \$12.
- 12. As required for District and State Tournament play spectators MUST remain off all fairways and greens.
- 13. Coaches, parents, students, and/or spectators are prohibited from giving advice to players, scorers, and tournament officials throughout this event just like District and State Tournament play.
- 14. In the event of inclement weather, a decision will be made by 8 am on Saturday morning and an email sent out. The golf course may be contacted directly as well at 410-448-4653.
