



I. GENERAL INFORMATION

- A. The Maryland Public Secondary Schools Athletic Association is the official governing body for the Golf tournament. Plans for the tournament were formulated by the State Golf Committee and approved by the Board of Control.
- B. Schools choosing to enter the tournament have the responsibility for reading and adhering to the rules and regulations stated in the front section of this publication as well as those appearing within this Golf Bulletin.
- C. Eligibility rules for all participants are defined in MPSSAA Bylaw .02, found in the current MPSSAA Handbook.
- D. General regulations for all state tournaments are contained in MPSSAA Bylaw .07, found in both the current Handbook and in the front section of this publication.

II. DISTRICT AND STATE TOURNAMENTS

- A. Tournament Organization
 - 1. The tournament is open to boys and girls. Girls are subject to the same rules as boys, with the exception of playing from women’s tees in district and state play.
 - 2. The entry for district and state competition must be signed by the coach, athletic director, and the school principal, or the entry will be denied.
 - 3. Determining district championships and qualifying for the state tournament:
 - a. The tournament will be divided into two classifications: 4A/3A and 2A/1A. The top one-eighth (1/8) of each classification’s teams and top one-eighth (1/8) of the remaining players qualify for the state tournament.
 - b. Teams for the district tournament may consist of five players plus individual qualifiers.
 - (1) The maximum team qualifying score is 340, regardless of its place in the District tournament.
 - (2) Count the LOW FOUR towards the team score. If the fifth player (the individual with the highest score) qualifies, he/she may participate in the state tournament on an individual basis only.
 - (3) District chairmen will submit six additional qualifying alternates in numerical order.

- c. A boys individual champion, girls individual champion, and a 1A/2A and 3A/4A team champion will be awarded.

B. Playing Rules

1. Each entrant will play 18 holes of stroke play. The four-player team with the lowest aggregate score for 72 holes shall be the district champion. Schools without teams may enter individuals in District play.
2. To advance to the state tournament from the district tournament, individuals must shoot a qualifying score determined by the following formula:

“Course rating +X strokes = qualifying score for that course”

- a. All districts’ course ratings will be used in the equation. The adjustment factor, “X”, will be determined by the state committee and distributed to all district representatives.
- b. All district tournaments shall be played at the distances shown on their course scorecards.
- c. Course rating for boys is from the middle or white tees.
- d. Course rating for girls is from the red or women’s tees.

C. General Policies

1. District tournament director will be responsible for the assignment of duties. It is highly recommended that the representatives from schools at the district tournament be assigned as scorers or marshals.
2. In order to accommodate all players, the state committee may adjust the district alignment when the committee determines an overcrowding of district participants.

III. STATE TOURNAMENT

A. Tournament Organization

1. There will be two separate two-day tournaments. Class 4A/3A will compete in a one-day 18-hole semifinal round on Monday, October 19. Class 2A/1A will compete in a one-day 18-hole semifinal round on Tuesday, October 20. Teams and individuals qualifying from the semifinals rounds will return on Wednesday, October 21, for state final play. Overall results will be based on cumulative scores from the semifinals and finals.

2. There will be a meeting of the State Golf Committee on Wednesday, October 14, at 10 a.m. District chairmen should bring a completed 3 x 5 card for each person qualifying for the state tournament (see sample).
3. The 2009 state tournament will be held at Potomac Ridge golf course. Semifinal rounds will take place Monday, October 19 (4A/3A) and Tuesday, October 20 (2A/1A). Qualifiers from October 19 and October 20 semifinal rounds will compete Wednesday, October 21.

4. Directions for State Tournament

From route 95 (Capital Beltway) : Take I-95 to Exit 2 on Route 210 South, (Indian Head Highway). Proceed 8 miles and turn left onto Farmington Road. Proceed 1 mile and continue straight through a 4-way stop. Farmington road becomes Berry road. Continue on Berry Road until it ends at Accokeek Road (Route 373) where you will see signs to the golf course. Take a right on Accokeek Road then first left on Sharperville road. Golf course entrance is at the end of Sharperville Road.

From Annapolis and Points East: Take Route 301 South (Crain Highway) towards Richmond, continue on 301 to just North of Waldorf. Make right on Brandywine Road. Proceed ¼ mile and veer left on Route 373 (Accokeek Road) continue through stoplight. Proceed 6 miles on Accokeek Road. Then make a left on Sharperville Road. Golf course entrance is at the end of Sharperville Road.

From Waldorf and Points South: Take, Route 301 North towards Baltimore. In Waldorf make a left turn on Acton Road. Continue on Acton road and it will become Gardner Road. Turn left on Accokeek Road. Take Accokeek for 1.5 miles and make a left on Sharperville Road. Golf course entrance is at the end of Sharperville Road.

5. Each district shall provide the following personnel who will be assigned by the state golf committee as scorers or marshals.
 - a. **Coaches or school representative in lieu of coach** are expected to be available to assist in scoring each day.
 - b. On Wednesday, October 21, all coaches with remaining athletes must be available to assist in scoring.
6. The tournament director will assign competitors on the basis of schools represented and scores reported on the entry blank. Players from the same school will not play together.
7. Even though four golfers from the same school may qualify as individuals, they do not constitute a team and must compete as individuals.
8. **Tournament play will begin with a 'shotgun' start at 10:00 a.m. each day. Coaches or school-designated representatives (representatives must present on school letterhead a document stating their designation as the school representative and it must signed by the athletic director or school principal) are responsible for signing in all participants at least 30 minutes before starting time. Time should be allowed for traffic, etc. Players and coaches/school representatives who fail to report before the starting time will be scratched.**
9. Method used to determine champions
 - a. The four-member team with the lowest aggregate score for 144 holes shall be declared the state team champion.
 - b. The individual (boy and girl) with the lowest aggregate score for 36 holes shall be declared the state individual champion.
10. Designated alternates are eligible to participate in team competition upon determination of the individual coach on the scheduled tournament day.

B. General Policies

1. Advancement standards for qualifying from semifinals to finals:
 - a. TOP ONE-HALF OF TEAMS (up to 50%) from each semifinal.
EXAMPLE: 10 teams - 5 qualify; 11 teams - 5 qualify.
 - b. TOP ONE-HALF OF INDIVIDUAL male and female competitors from each semifinal.
 - c. Ties for the team final advancement place: tied teams will be played off by starting from the first hole and continue until the tie is broken.
 - d. ALL INDIVIDUALS who tie the cutoff score will advance.
2. Within each classification (4A/3A and 2A/1A), each of the top two teams will receive a plaque. Each member of the winning team will receive a golf charm. Awards will be presented to the top overall individual male and female players.
 - a. Ties for first place will be resolved by playoff, starting on the first hole and continuing until the tie is broken. All other individual ties will stand.
 - b. In case of a tie for first team honors, the teams involved start from the first hole and continue on until the tie is broken.
3. The number of individual awards may be reduced in the proportion to the number of participants in district and state play.
4. All equipment, including balls, shall be furnished by the competing teams or individuals.

C. Playing Rules

1. The regular green fee is expected for all practice rounds. No free practice rounds will be permitted on the course prior to the tournament.
 - a. Only a limited number are available on the weekend prior to the tournament.
 - b. Coaches are reminded of MPSSAA regulations prohibiting Sunday practice and may not accompany players to Sunday practice rounds.
2. Coaches are responsible for reviewing the rules of stroke play with their players.
3. The use of the middle or white tees for males and red tees for females will apply in the tournament. Summer rules will be in effect if warranted by course conditions.
4. An official scorer will accompany each foursome to assist play and carry the official score card.
 - a. Golfers are expected to keep their own score and should verify it with the scorer after each hole.
 - b. Golfers must sign the official score card after each round prior to its submission by the official scorer to the match director.
 - c. Any unsportsmanlike action directed at these officials, such as abusive language, shall result in suspension from tournament play.
5. Local rules of the host club shall be observed implicitly. An official school representative from each competing school shall be responsible for such compliance by members of his/her group. The tournament director may delegate the responsibility to rule on technical questions arising from play to some other person; however, should there be any reservations on a ruling that was made some time after a questionable problem or development, the situation may only be resolved through action of the tournament committee as designated by the tournament director.

6. Closing of the course due to inclement weather
 - a. In the event a semifinal on Monday OR Tuesday is postponed, the postponed semifinal will be contested on October 21. Based on the availability of Potomac Ridge golf course, a possible second 18-hole final could be completed on October 26.
 - b. In case both Monday AND Tuesday semifinals are postponed, BOTH the 4A/3A and the 2A/1A semifinals will be conducted on Wednesday, October 21. Based on the availability of Potomac Ridge golf course, a possible second 18-hole final could be completed on October 26.
7. Participating players are prohibited from using tobacco products during the tournament.
8. Participating players and coaches are prohibited from using cell phones during the tournament.
9. All players must wear appropriate nonmetal cleated shoes and may not play barefooted.
10. All players must wear appropriate golf attire.
11. The use of a caddie or golf cart is not permitted.
12. Spectators must remain off all fairways and greens.
13. Coaches, parents, students, and/or spectators are prohibited from giving advice to players, scorers, and tournament officials throughout the tournament.
14. In the best interest of the tournament, excessively slow play cannot be tolerated. Course marshals will be instructed to warn slow players. Should individuals receive more than two warnings because of slow play, those warned shall be eliminated from further play.
15. **Range finders are allowed, however, they are not permitted to be shared with other competitors.**

Basic rule to determine slow play: OPEN TEE - OPEN GREEN
