POSITION TITLE: MPSSAA Football Rules Interpreter (for the playing rules of the National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS) Rule Book on High School Football)

NATURE OF WORK: This is a position with the responsibility of interpreting NFHS football rules and disseminating those interpretations throughout the state.

DUTIES: The position of MPSSAA Football Rules Interpreter is to represent the MPSSAA at the NFHS meetings; to plan and conduct rules clinics prior to the start of the season; to be available to interpret NFHS rules to coaches, athletic directors, officials, and supervisors; to provide input and feedback to the MPSSAA Coordinator of Officials on the state of the game, the state of officiating, and assignment of football officials to state tournaments; to up-date the MPSSAA six-man mechanics manual annually; to attend and observe the state tournaments.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Maryland resident; availability of up to twenty-five (25) evenings a year; extensive background in high school football and national federation rules.

REQUIREMENTS: Applicants must have good oral and written communication skills as well as be able to speak comfortably in front of groups. Computer literacy including proficiency with Microsoft word, excel, and power point. Use of technology and experience in interpretation, teaching, training, and instructing the application of high school football rules, the application of proper mechanics of officiating, and being able to provide appropriate feedback and professional development is preferable. Five years officiating high school football is preferred.

STIPEND: The MPSSAA annually budgets a stipend as recommended by the MPSSAA Finance Committee for rules interpretation clinics, trainings, and interpretations.
