Quiz #1 Answers

1. Call official's time out. Card the white team coach. Allow goalie to retrieve her throat protector. Proceed with the corner. (Rule 1-7-7)
2. Call official's time out. Card the white team coach. Remove white defender. Allow another white player to come back from the 50 yd. line to defend the corner. Resume the penalty corner with a whistle and game clock re-starts. The removed player, after complying with the rules, or her sub may enter the field through the substitution area after the ball has been injected to start the penalty corner. (Rule 1-6 PEN)
3. Free hit to the red attack on the dotted hash circle near the spot where the ball landed. (Rule 8-2-PEN1)
4. Blow whistle to stop the penalty corner (no time out). The white defender is sent to the 50-yard line. Reset the corner with one fewer defender. (Rule 10-3-PEN1)
5. Air dribbling above the shoulder in close proximity to defenders causing evasive action is considered dangerous. Free hit to the white defense. (Rule 8-1-1)
6. Incorrect procedure. Be preventive and let the players know the horn may sound and the official should allow play to continue until the corner is completed. (Rule 10-3-1)
7. Yes, this is correct procedure. (Rule 10-3-2c)
8. Goal. When the ball travels more than 5 yards outside the circle, the penalty corner is considered to be complete. (Rule 10-3-2d)
