

MPSSAA FIELD HOCKEY QUIZ #3 ANSWERS

Overtime

1. The visiting team captain shall call the coin toss. In subsequent tie-breaking procedures requiring a coin toss, the call of the toss shall always be called by the visiting team. P. 86, A1
2. False. The winner of the toss shall have the option of starting with the ball or the opponent starting with the ball. Teams do NOT change goals at the end of the regulation game. P. 88, E5
3. A player serving a 5-minute suspension when the regulation game ends must serve the remainder of the five minutes of playing time during the overtime period and the team will play short. The suspended player shall not enter the first overtime period until her suspension time has expired. P86 C3
4. True. Play two 10-minute sudden-victory overtime periods. MPSSAA Bulletin, State modification. p.16 E3
5. B. If the goalkeeper becomes the stroker, she shall wear a mouth protector; however, she may remove any other equipment if it does not result in undue delay of the game. P. 57 11-2-2
6. Retake the stroke. If a stroke is taken before the whistle and a goal is scored, the penalty stroke is taken again. P. 58 11-2-9c
7. Incorrect positioning. Lead positioning is a few feet to the right and approximately 3-5 yards behind the stroker. Official's Guide p. 89, X-5a and p. 81 Diagram K.
8. Yes. The stokers and/or the order of the stokers may be changed for the second set of strokes. P.87 Official's Guide E-3a
