1. When setting up a penalty corner, the official notices the white team goalie is not wearing a throat protector. What is the proper procedure?
2. When setting up a penalty corner, the official notices a white defender, who is wearing earrings, standing behind the end line. What is the proper procedure?
3. When saving a shot, the white team goalie's clear rises safely over the heads of all players. The ball lands between two opponents standing within marking distance outside the circle. What is the call?
4. During a penalty corner, a white defender enters the circle before the red attack injects the ball to start the penalty corner. What should the official do?
5. Red attack is air dribbling in close proximity to white defenders. The attack player plays the ball above shoulder height as she moves past her opponents, causing them to move away. Is this a "play on"?
6. With 30 seconds remaining the first half, a penalty corner is awarded. The red attack injects the ball to start the penalty corner and as play continues in the circle, the clock runs out and the timer sounds a horn to end the half. The official blows his/her whistle to signal the end of the half. Is this correct procedure?
7. While playing out a prolonged corner at the end of the first half, the ball is injected to start the penalty corner and travels three yards outside the circle. A white defender inadvertently kicks the ball while it is still outside the circle. The official signals the half over. Is this correct procedure?
8. On a penalty corner, the red injector hits the ball which travels 1 foot outside the dotted hash circle. The ball is then brought into the striking circle. The red attack hits the ball, using a backswing, and the ball crosses the goal line 2 feet in the air. Goal or no goal?
