

Answer Sheet Quiz #1

1. Penalty corner. Since the foul was on the lifted ball, it occurred in the circle.
2. Whistle and move the defender back. The ball was not put into play yet. P. 24, Rule 3-2-11. *Playing the ball is stopping deflecting or moving the ball with the stick.*
3. Whistle end of quarter. The penalty corner was over. P. 44, Rule 10-3-1f. *The penalty corner awarded (regulation or extended play) shall be considered complete when: (f) A defender commits a foul which does not result in another penalty corner.*
4. The player gets the card. P. 38, Rule 8-2-PENALTIES4. For misconduct by a player(s) during any stoppage of the game clock, the player(s) shall be carded.
5. Goal. P. 44, Rule 10-2-7. *If the first shot at goal is a hit (as opposed to a push, flick or scoop), the ball must cross the goal line, or be on a path which would have resulted in it crossing the goal line, no higher than 18 inches before any deflection, for a goal to be scored.* In this case, the hit was the second shot.
