1. To establish a legal screening position, the following are true:
 - a) Time and distance are relevant.
 - b) The screener must be stationary, except when both the screener and opponent are moving in the same path and the same direction.
 - c) The screener must stay within his/her vertical plane with a stance approximately shoulders width apart.
 - d) The screener may face any direction.
 - e) All of the above.

2. To be deemed a try, it is not essential that the ball leave the shooter's hand as a foul could prevent the release of the ball. True or False?

3. A-1 is fouled by B-1 while Team A is in the bonus. The trail official reports the foul and A-1 then taunts B-1. The trail official rules a technical foul on A-1 and it is A-1's fifth foul. Which of the following are correct:
 - a. A-1 will shoot the bonus free throws.
 - b. This is a false double foul.
 - c. This is a double foul.
 - d. A-1's substitute will shoot his/her bonus free throw.
 - e. B and D.

4. A-1 pushes B-1 and Team B is in the bonus. It's A-1 fourth foul and then A-1 curses at the trail official. The trail official rules a technical foul on A-1 for unsporting conduct. Which of the following are true:
 - a. The trail official should ignore A-1 because he/she has the right to their opinion, even if it's unsporting.
 - b. This is a false multiple foul.
 - c. Penalize the fouls in the order of occurrence.
 - d. A-1 is disqualified.
 - e. All of the Above.
 - f. B, C, and D.

5. A-1 is fouled by B-2 and is awarded two free throws. The foul on B-2 is his/her fifth foul. The new trail official reports the foul to the official scorer and informs the Head Coach of Team B that B-2 has five fouls. Before the substitution is made, the lead official incorrectly permits A-1 to attempt the first free throw. Which of the following are true:
 - a. Re-administer A-1's free throws.
 - b. A-1 will shoot his/her second free throw and the first free throw will not be re-administered.
