

2017 MPSSAA Basketball Quiz #18

Questions:

1. The throw-in and the throw-in count begin when the ball is at the disposal of the player inbounding the ball. True or False?
2. When is the ball considered to be at the disposal of the player inbounding the ball?
3. When does the throw-in count end?
4. The designated throw-in spot is 3 feet wide with no depth limitation. True or False?
5. The traveling and dribbling rules are not in effect for a throw-in. True or False?

Answers:

1. True; Rule 4-42-3.
2. When the ball is handed to the player inbounding the ball, when the ball is caught by the player inbounding the ball after the ball was bounced to them, when the ball is placed on the floor, when the ball is made available to a player after a goal, and when the administering official begins the throw-in count. Rule 4-4-7 (a-d).
3. The throw-in count ends when the ball is released by the player inbounding the ball as it passes directly into the court. Rule 4-42-4.
4. True; Rule 4-42-6.
5. True; Rule 4-42-6 (Exception).
