Questions:

1. Tape may be used to extend the 14-foot line to 28 feet when dealing with the coaching box. True or False?
2. This year, when reporting fouls to the table, the calling official will use two hands with the exception of single digit numbers. True or False?
3. When reporting a foul, the official shall say “two-four blue” and not “twenty-four blue”. True or False?
4. The panel of the shoulder area on the back of the jersey may be used for placing an identifying name. True or False?
5. A warning to a coach/team for misconduct is an administrative procedure by an official which is recorded in the scorebook by the scorer and reported to the Head Coach. True or False?
6. The Coach of Team A curses at the trail official and the same official issues a behavioral warning. True or False?
7. The Coach of Team A leaves their coaching box, stands in front of the scoring table and yells "play 34" to their team. The trail official issues a behavioral warning. True or False?
8. The ball is at the disposal of the in-bounder when the in-bounder catches the ball. True or False?
9. The ball is at the disposal of the free thrower when the free thrower catches the ball. True or False?
10. Player A presents a doctor's note to the officials which indicates that the player must wear a head covering for medical reasons. Is this permitted? Yes or No?
11. Coach A advises the officials that they have a player that must wear a head covering for religious reasons. The officiating crew permits a non-dangerous covering or wrap to be worn as long as the head coach and athletic director have followed the process deemed appropriate by the State. True or False?
12. During a throw-in, 10-seconds, 3-seconds, front court status, back court status, closely guarded, etc. are not factors as there has yet to be player control/team control obtained inbounds. True or False?
13. When the in-bounding team fouls during a throw-in, it's a team control foul unless it's an intentional or flagrant personal foul. True or False?
14. When does a throw-in end?
15. In-bounder A-1 has a throw-in in their front court. A-1 throws the ball to airborne player A-2 who catches the ball in their front court and lands in their back court. Is this a legal play? Yes or No?
16. Same scenario as in question 15, but A-1 lands on one foot in the front court and steps into the backcourt. This is a back court violation. True or False?
17. In-bounder A-1 has a throw-in in their front court. A-1 throws the ball to A-2 who fumbles the ball into the back court. A-3 picks the ball up in the back court. The trail official rules a back court violation. True or False?

18. What is the penalty for an intentional personal foul?
19. What is the penalty for an intentional technical foul?
20. Any player can shoot an intentional personal foul. True or False?
