- 2. Team A's Head Coach requested a time-out for the officiating crew to assess whether Team A did not receive a merited free throw. The officiating crew discusses and realizes that Team A's Head Coach is correct. Is Team A charged with a time-out? Yes or No?
- 3. In question 2, if the error is not correctable, is Team A charged with a time-out? Yes or No?
- 4. The ball is considered to be at the disposal of the inbounding player when the ball is placed at the spot on the floor. True or False?
- 5. A flagrant foul is not a common foul. True or False?
