Questions:

- 1. A-1 grabs the rebound at Team B's basket. A-1 throws a pass and the ball is intercepted by an airborne B-5 in their front court, but B-5 lands with the ball in the back court. Is this a back court violation? Yes or No?
- 2. Same scenario as question 1, but an airborne B-5 comes down with one foot in the front court and then steps into the back court. Is this a back court violation? Yes or No?
- 3. Same scenario as question 1, but an airborne B-5 comes down with both feet in their front court and then steps into the back court. Is this a back court violation? Yes or No?
- 4. A-1 is dribbling the ball in their front court. A-1 ends their dribble and passes the ball to A-3 who leaps from their backcourt, catches the ball while in the air, and then lands in their front court. Is this a back court violation? Yes or No?
- 5. Team A has a throw-in in their front court. Inbounder A-1 throws the ball to A-2 who is straddling the division line. Is this a back court violation? Yes or No?
