- 2. In question #1, if the game clock horn sounded, how would the goal count?
- 3. In question #1, if the shot clock horn sounded, how would the goal count?
- 4. A-1 and B-1 taunt one another simultaneously as A-3 is dribbling the ball in their back court. Team A will receive the ball in their back court at the point of interruption. True or False?
- 5. In question #4, will Team A receive a new 10-second count. Yes or No?
- 6. In question # 4, will the shot clock be reset? Yes or No?
- 7. While A-5 is shooting the second of two free throws, the ball lodges in the ring. What is the correct way to handle this situation?
- 8. A-1 is fouled by B-5 on a lay-up. While the ball is in the cylinder, A-3 touches the ball. The center official rules offensive basket interference and awards A-1 two shots. True or False?
- 9. While A-1 is dribbling the ball in their back court the ball is intentionally kicked by B-1. Team A will receive a new 10-second count. Yes or No?
- 10. There are no successive time-outs at the end of regulation play or at the expiration of any overtime period. True or False?
