1. Under a slow whistle, unless a scoring play is imminent, play shall be suspended upon any second foul, anywhere on the field. True or False?
2. Under NFHS rules, a player hit in a “defenseless position” is defined as follows: a. blind side hit; b. head down scooping the ball; c. head turned receiving a pass. True or False?
3. A player throwing his crosse at the ball would receive a technical foul. True or False?
4. An offensive player in possession of the ball cannot initiate head contact with the defenseman. Penalty is a one-minute non-releasable foul on the offensive player for spearing. True or False?
5. Holding a player with the handle of the crosse is legal as long as the defensive player’s shoulders are no greater than shoulder width apart and there is no thrusting motion. True or False?
6. It is now legal to re-start the ball with a defensive player within five yards of the player in possession, but the offensive player SHOULD be starting from a “stopped” position. True or False?
7. A shot released from above the goal line extended BEFORE the period ends which enters the goal AFTER the horn is now legal as long as it does not hit another offensive player on its way to the goal. True or False?
8. Targeting a player is a minimum of a three-minute foul and could be cause for ejection. True or False?
9. A player could get a three-minute non-releasable penalty for a stick violation, if he pulls the strings after an official asks for his stick. (Trick question) True or False?
10. “Warding off” cannot be called if player has two hands on the stick. (Read closely) True or False?
