- 1: d. The timer must sound the horn again at the end of the 15-second interval, even if the substitute is ready. (IAABO Manual p. 372)
 - 2: c. Headbands, wristbands, arm sleeves, leg sleeves, compression shorts, and tights
 - 3: False Contacting the ball while it is in the thrower's hand is a player technical foul, not an intentional foul. (NFHS 10-4)
 - 4: Since technical foul occurs after the ball becomes dead to end the period, the free throws are administered to start the 3rd quarter at the basket for the 3rd quarter. The home team begins the 3rd quarter with one team foul.
 - 5: False. On a division line throw-in violation, the resulting throw-in remains at the division line, not advanced to the frontcourt. (IAABO January 2026 Rules Interpretation — confirmed through IAABO/NFHS discussion)

Situation:

- While free thrower A1 has started the throwing motion
- B1 pushes A2 along the lane line.
- After the contact, B2, who is in a marked lane space, enters the lane too soon.

Q1: In this situation, the foul does not cause the ball to become dead immediately, so the play includes two infractions: first a foul, then a violation.

Q2: If the free throw is successful, the basket counts. If the try is unsuccessful, Team A is awarded a substitute.

Q3: Only the head coach and team bench may receive an unsporting conduct warning, which is recorded in the scorebook.

Q4: The scorer is responsible for maintaining the alternating-possession arrow.

Q5: When should officials remove their jackets when working a two or three person crew?

- a. When warm-ups are completed
- b. When the National Anthem is completed
- c. When player introductions are completed
- d. Right before the tip-off

Answers:

Q1: True. The continuous motion applies (4-11)

Q2: True. Even though the foul occurred first, violation is the first to be penalized if A1's try is unsuccessful. (4-11, 6-7 Exception C, 9-1 Penalty 2)

Q3: True (C.B. 4.48 Note)

Q4: True. The scorer is responsible for recording and maintaining the alternating-possession arrow, while the referee verifies its accuracy. (2-11-7)

Q5: When warm-ups are completed. (IAABO Manual p. 373; 2-7-6; NFHS Officials Manual p.11)
