Offense- Mountain Ridge operates out of a Spread Offense with heavy emphasis on the RPO. 50/50 mix of run pass. Very undersized line but use quickness to pull and kick or pin. This is their 3rd straight semi-finals appearance, having gone to the state championship game the last two. Team has a 24 game home win streak at the "Mine Shaft". Will Patterson is a college prospect as an Athlete. Dayton Llwellyn is a prospect as an OL/DL. Andrew Ketterman will play college football too.

They spread the ball around to multiple people in the offense with at least 4 WR with at least 5 TDs.

Offensive Coordinator Sefa Pua'aulli started at Hawaii and Rutgers as an OL

Defensive- 4-2-5 base defense with the ability to jump into an odd front.

Defensive Coordinator played Linebacker at WVU

They attack from multiple angles on defense and apply heavy pressure to any system

Quick to attack the football and rely on team swarm.

MR is 39-4 in their last 43 games with their only 4 losses being to state power Fort Hill.
