Highlights from the Spring 2026 Bulletin:

- Semifinals will be held at Bachmann Sports Complex in Glen Burnie --- 8 games to be played on Tuesday, May 19, beginning at 4:00 p.m. (raindate Wednesday, May 20)
- Finals will be played at the University of Maryland Softball Complex – as of right now, two games on Friday, May 22, and two games on Saturday, May 23. Schedule to be determined at the completion of the semifinal games.
- **Last play date for seeding will be Monday, May 4. Seeding will occur on May 5.**
- **First round of regionals will be played on Thursday, May 7.**
- **Region finals are set for Wednesday, May 13, with the state quarterfinals set for Friday, May 15. If either region winner has a prom on Friday, May 15, the quarterfinal game will be played on Saturday, May 16.**

Scores are to be submitted by coaches/AD's so that they can be included on the MPSSAA website. **It is most important that we have your prom and graduation dates before regionals begin. We are most willing to work with schools, but we must know ahead of time if a conflict might occur.**
