## **Questions**:

- 1. Which team is responsible for bringing the ball back to center after a goal?
- 2. List the seven conditions under which a penalty corner is completed.
- 3. What is the "mercy" rule (clock continues to run after goals scored) for Maryland?
- 4. On a penalty corner, the first shot at goal is a hit along the ground. A post-side attack player deflects the ball safely into the top corner of the cage. Goal or no goal?
- 5. A player has a stick with an indentation in the toe of the left hand side of her stick. The name on the stick is the "Scoop". Is this legal for high school play?
- 6. The score of a game is 5-0 with 23 seconds left in the second half when a penalty corner in favor of the winning team is called. The attack sets up the corner and the ball is inserted. During play in the circle the time on the clock expires. Should the umpire blow his/her whistle to end the game?
- 7. Prior to the insertion on a penalty corner, defender A-10 jumps over the end line before the ball is inserted. The umpire sends A-10 back to the 50-yard line and resets the corner. During the replaying of the corner, the defense kicks the ball in the circle and the umpire calls another corner. Is A-10 permitted to defend this corner or should the Team A have three field players plus the goalie behind the end line?
- 8. Attack player B-15 is taking a free hit inside her attacking 25-yard area. She hits it three yards as a teammate who was 5 yards away before the ball was hit by B-15, rushes in to hit the ball into the circle. What is the call?
