

This is a photo of a defender attempting to outlet the ball in the circle and being obstructed by the offensive stick. The ball then hit the defender's foot and a corner was called.

Be sure you are moving your feet to have the angle to see the ball.

Don't blow noise.

Consider who has possession of the ball and who is coming to defend?

Where are the sticks? Are they in a good position to play the ball?

What direction does the ball travel after the tackle?

We want to be balanced in our umpiring of corners.

When a defender is fouled in the circle it is rarely an advantage situation, give them their free hit.
