Subject: Information Regarding the 2019-20 Wrestling Season

1. The state dual meet championship will be held at North Point High School on Saturday, February 15,

- 2. The state individual wrestling tournament will be held at the The Show Place Arena in Upper Marlboro on March 5-7, 2020.
- 3. There is now a girls division for the state championship. Female wrestlers may choose to enter the girls division or their respective classification division for any gender. Entry registration into the Female division must be completed by 4 p.m. on Wednesday, February 19th. The top two wrestlers in each weight class of the eight regions will advance to a single classification 16-line bracket at the state tournament. The first girl rounds will be on Thursday Night. See the bulletin for more info.
- 4. The state dual meet championship is all four classifications. With this addition to the dual tournament, the team scores have been removed from the individual regional and state championships.
- 5. Coaches should review all materials and publications related to local, state, and National Federation of High Schools (NFHS) regulations. These include, but are not limited to, the MPSSAA winter bulletin, NFHS Wrestling Rules Book, and the MPSSAA Weight Certification/Management Program.
- 6. Procedures described in the MPSSAA Weight Certification/Management Program must be followed in establishing safe minimum weight classes The weight management forms and information are available on the MPSSAA website.
- 7. Weigh-in procedures for all matches and tournaments will adhere precisely to Rule 4, Section 5, Article 1-9 of the NFHS Wrestling Rules Book. Teams may only participate in contest or tournaments that adhere to these regulations. *Interpretation- Monday events shall have a one pound allowance*
- 8. All schedules must be finalized and submitted to the local supervisor of athletics prior to December 5, 2019. Schedule additions or modifications may not be made after this date.
- Schools, coaches, and wrestlers should exercise diligence in minimizing risks of communicable diseases and skin infection. Procedures for limiting spread can be found in the NFHS Rules Book and on the MPSSAA website
- 10. Wrestlers suspected of having a communicable skin infection must complete the NFHS form Medical Release for Wrestler to Participate with Skin Lesion form in order to participate.
