Quick Tips:

1. Before administering a throw-in, “sweep” the floor, make eye contact with your partner(s), find your clock(s), observe the table for any substitutions.
2. Go over Rule-4-12, the entire rule, player control and team control.
3. Use two concepts when adjudicating rebounding fouls:
  - A. Possession Consequence- Patient Whistle.
  - B. Clean-Up- Immediate Whistle.

Rebounding Coverage- “3” Person

- A. Lead- Strong Side.
- B. Center- Weak Side.
- C. Trail- Perimeter and will assist on Weak and Strong Side.
