QUIZ 1

True/False :

Q1: Team A is granted a 60-second time-out. After the 15-second warning horn has sounded, A6 reports to the scorer's table requesting to substitute. The official denies A6 entry into the game.

Q2: Following Q1, before the clock has started, Team A requests another 60-second time-out. The official allows it.

Q3: During a successive time-out, substitute A6 reports to the scorer's table before the 15-second warning horn. The official denies the substitution, stating it is the same dead-ball request.

Q4: At halftime, no Team A member or representative reports which players will start the 3rd quarter. As a result, the five players who finished the 2nd quarter will start the 3rd quarter.

Q5: During the 4th quarter, Team A has multiple players injured and is left with only one player. The official declares the game forfeited.

Answers:

Q1: True. (3-3-1a)

Q2: True. (4-43-2) This is a "successive time-out", which may be granted to either team if properly requested.

Q3: False. (IRG Play 16-2-2, 3-3-1) A6 is eligible to enter since the substitute reported before the 15-second warning horn during the time-out.

Q4: True. (IRG Play 16-2-4, 3-3-1a Note) If no lineup is reported, the players who ended the previous quarter are considered the starters for the next quarter.

Q5: Answer: False. (3-1-1) The official can allow Team A to continue with one player only if the referee believes that Team A still has an opportunity to win the game.

QUIZ 2

1. A1's try is in flight, time expires in the 3rd quarter. Prior to the try ending, A2 is charged with a technical foul. The officials start the 4th quarter by administering the free throws for the technical foul. The officials are not correct. T-F

2. Each quarter or extra period begins when the ball first becomes live. T-F
3. A1 attempts a try and the ball misses the entire ring and the shot clock expires. The officials rule a shot clock violation. T-F
4. Shot Clocks should be recessed and mounted on the backboard supports behind each backboard. T-F
5. An alternate- timing device or procedure shall be available when a visible shot clock malfunctions. T-F

1. A1 scores on a lay-up. The Head Coach of Team B uses language at the Trail Official that is profane & violent. The officials issues a warning to the Head Coach of Team B. T-F

2. A1 scores on a lay-up. The Head Coach of Team B uses language that is argumentative to the Trail Official. The Trail Official issues a warning to The Head Coach of Team B which is recorded in the scorebook. T-F

3. A1 scores on a lay-up. The Head Coach of Team B questions the officiating crew's integrity. The officials rule a direct technical foul on the Head Coach of Team B. T-F

4. A pass by A1 comes down several feet in front of the basket. The ball strikes the floor and enters the basket. The basket counts and credit two points to A1. T-F
