Board of Control Update

The MPSSAA Board of Control held its annual winter meeting on December 11, 2013. The following are highlights from the meeting.

- * Approved the 2014 Spring Bulletins.
- * Accepted the 2013 spring and fall financial report, 2013 fall sports' reports and the 2013-14 winter sports' updates.
- * Elected Kim Dolch, Principal North Carroll HS, as MPSSAA President and Greg LeGrand, Anne Arundel County Coordinator of Athletics for MPSSAA President-Elect.

Dolch and LeGrand Elected

The Board of Control at their annual winter meeting on December 11, 2013 elected Kim Dolch as President and Greg LeGrand President-elect of the MPSSAA.

Dolch is the Principal at North Carroll High School in Carroll County. She served as President of the Monocacy Valley Athletic League (MVAL) comprised of Carroll, Frederick and Washington County schools in 2010. She was President of the Maryland Association of Secondary School Principals from April 2010-April 2011 and a 2009 nominee for Principal of the Year.

LeGrand is the Coordinator of Athletics for Anne Arundel County. He serves as the Treasurer of District 5 and represents the district on the Executive Council, Board of Control, and numerous other standing committees. LeGrand also serves as site director of the Boy's Basketball Championships.

Region Meet Procedures For Indoor Track

The State Indoor Track & Field Committee needs results from all regular season meets to verify entries into the region meets. All entries MUST be verifiable performances from the current season. A performance is considered verifiable if it is posted on the results listing (mpssaa.org) by the deadline of 1/29/14. To have results posted, they must be sent via email to Gerard Filosa at mdstatetrackmeet@gmail.com. Be sure to go to www.mpssaa.org for information including a results listing.

Please note, there are new entry procedures for entering schools into the indoor track region tournament. Please review the letter on page 3 of this newsletter.

Wrestling Proposal and Survey

The MPSSAA Wrestling Committee has been submitted a proposal to adjust the current format of the MPSSAA state dual meet and individual state wrestling championship tournaments. The key elements of the proposal include expanding the state dual meet tournament to include team championships in all four MPSSAA classifications, while unifying the individual tournament – one individual state champion per weight class. The plan includes eliminating team scoring from the individual state championships at Cole Field House, and determining team championships exclusively through the dual meet tournament.

At its October 9, 2013 meeting, the MPSSAA Wrestling Committee voted to submit this proposal to schools for further consideration. The proposal is scheduled to be on the agenda for consideration by the MPSSAA Wrestling Committee at the 2013-14 postseason meeting (March 25, 2014). The intent of this survey is for schools and the wrestling community to discuss and consider whether this proposal would benefit Maryland public school wrestling. EXECUTIVE'S

CORNER

How things have changed! That certainly can be said about most everything from societal attitudes towards social behavior to breathtaking technological advances. On the athletic front, it is no longer your father's concept of amateurism.

Historically we are reminded of Jim Thorpe one of America's finest athletes being stripped of his Olympic track medals because of his participation in professional football. Some might remember the 1972 US Olympic men's basketball team, comprised of college players, losing the gold medal to a team of Russian professionals. The definition of amateur athletics on national and world levels has been diametrically altered to allow for compensation of training expense, player product endorsement and "dream teams" of professionals. Those changes beg the question; if amateur rules have essentially gone away why do high schools and colleges hang on to the concept?

Amateur rules are essential to preserve any sense of fair play and equitable competition in an educationally based athletic program. With no restrictions it wouldn't take long before booster clubs or deep-pocketed alumns or supporters begin to financially reward players. Checkbooks would tip the balance in favor of those who could afford the more talented players. The very foundation of interscholastic athletics would be turned on its ear.

The MPSSAA regulations that define amateurism were adopted over 40 years ago. They simply say:

A. "Students who have not used or are not using their athletic skill as players for financial gain, or who have not competed under assumed names as players, shall be considered amateurs. Employment as an instructor, counselor, or official may not be considered a violation."

The brevity of that wording leaves many unanswered questions. The MPSSAA receives numerous requests from coaches, athletic directors, parents, camp directors and promoters seeking clarification. Can an athlete accept travel and lodging to a showcase camp? How much product can a high school student take home? Can a runner accept money or savings bonds as a prize in a road race? Can tennis players and golfers accept rackets, clubs and other equipment for participation in an outside school event?

Unfortunately, there are no national standards. National Governing Bodies differ from those of the NCAA that in turn differ from high school standards. For example, the NCAA allows tennis players to accept prize money up to \$10,000 and still retain collegiate eligibility. Certainly a standard way out of proportion for high school athletes.

So where are we? Maintaining the simplicity of the current regulation has merit. Perhaps the desirable strategy is to maintain the current rule and offer interpretive direction in response to the evolving nature of given circumstances.

A recommendation is that a review of the interpretations of the amateur rule be conducted and if needed expanded to provide clear standards for our athletes and coaches. Specifics can then be readily addressed to meet changing circumstances. Accomplishing that goal would be a good resolution for the New Year.

MPSSAA Indoor Track 2013-14 New Region Entry Procedures – MileSplit

Coaches, Athletic Directors,

This is a reminder that the online entries for the MPSSAA Region Meets will now be submitted via www.md.milesplit.com. The purpose of this letter is to remind coaches about the changes to the online entry system.

Some other reminders:

- There is a separate entry page for each meet, so be sure to enter the correct meet.
- All seed times must be verified. The default seed mark is the athlete's best performance of the season that can be found in MileSplit's performance database. If you wish to enter a mark that is not in MileSplit's database, you must enter the <u>REVISED MARK AND THE MEET (DATE AND MEET NAME)</u> the mark occurred at. Failure to do this may result in the seed time/mark being rejected.

Please be sure to start your entries early. Entries may be revised up until the meet deadline (posted in the MPSSAA bulletin).
