## 2014-15 Participation Survey

Participation for Maryland public high school athletics reached 113,045 participants in 2014-15. While participation slightly dropped from 2013-14, last year marked the eighth year in a row participation was over 110,000 and the 11th year in row over 100,000 participants. Schools participating in and hosting MPSSAA Tournament competition need to be aware of the Unmanned Aircraft Systems Policy found in the front section of the MPSSAA Bulletin. In the interest of public safety and competitive equity, the use of unmanned aircraft systems (drones) is prohibited during MPSSAA district, region, and state tournament competition. Drones may not operate in airspace over host school grounds or facilities conducting MPSSAA events.

## Girls Field Hockey

All schools must submit to their regional director their official record (excluding the designated optional tournament) for games through Wednesday, October 21st. Brackets for the tournaments will be made available on October 22nd.

## Football

The MPSSAA Football state championships will be played at M \& T Bank Stadium on December 3, 4 and 5th. The Class 3A state finals will be played on December 3th at 7:00 p.m., Class 4A on December 4th at 7:30 p.m., Class 1A and 2A will play on December 5th at 3:30 and 7:00 p.m.

Schools are reminded to report scores, regardless if you are home or away, as soon as possible at the end of each contest. This job should be appointed to a coach, manager, public address announcer, etc., to ensure that the final score is accurately reported each week.

Each week the MPSSAA will update the standings with Week 10 concluding the regular season and the top four teams in each region advancing to the region semi-finals. The proposed special alignments need to be ratified by the Classification Committee and by the MPSSAA Board of Control at their December meeting.

## Sanctioning Reminders

Multi-team events which include non-member Maryland schools that have not signed the Standards of Competition or any out of state schools requires the host school to file the appropriate sanction request form with the MPSSAA Executive Director PRIOR to the first play date of that particular
season (fall, winter, or spring) and at least 15 days prior to the event for events within the first two weeks of the season. Each request must include an official listing of participating schools before it can be processed for approval and posting on the MPSSAA.org website.

Multi-team events involving MPSSAA member schools or approved non-member Maryland schools that have signed the "Standards of Competition" DO NOT NEED TO BE SANC-
TIONED.
