Master Agreement Renewed Through 2031

A signing ceremony was held Friday May 6th, in Annapolis where all 24 school system Superintendants, along with State Superintendant Dr. Nancy Grasmick, and MPSSAA President Dr. William Beattie put their approval on a new Master Agreement for interscholastic athletics in Maryland state schools. The newly inked Agreement goes into effect on November 1st and will run through October 31, 2031.

Historically, the Master Agreement is a document that is enacted by the Maryland State Department of Education along with all of the local school systems to give authority to the MPSSAA for oversight, conduct, and operation of interscholastic athletic programs within the state. Each of the three entities involved has roles and responsibilities delineated in this document which create the cooperation, synergy, and support that has been the hallmark of interscholastic athletics in Maryland. The MPSSAA is looking forward to another twenty years of success!

New Weight Classes Announced For 2011-12 Wrestling Season

The most significant changes in weight classes in high school wrestling in 23 years will take place in the 2011-12 season. In its April 4-6 meeting in Indianapolis, the National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS) Wrestling Rules Committee approved an upward shift of the weight classes, beginning with the 103-pound class moving to 106 pounds, which resulted in new weights for 10 of the 14 classes. The changes in weight classes, along with 17 other rules revisions, were subsequently approved by the NFHS Board of Directors.

The 14 weight classes approved by the committee for 2011-12 are as follows:

106 (pounds), 113, 120, 126, 132, 138, 145, 152, 160, 170, 182, 195, 220 and 285.

Three middle weight classes – 145, 152 and 160 – were retained, although they are 7-8-9 in order now rather than 8-9-10. The largest weight class (285 pounds) remains unchanged as well.

Out-of-Season Teams Reminder

In an effort to be more precise regarding the role school coaches may play with nonschool teams, the following list of activities are offered as examples of violations to the out-of-season practice rule.

Some of the characteristics of a school team that is practicing out of season under the guise of an out-of-school team would include...

- Holding more than one practice per day of competition.
- Holding practices that are not directly related to summer league schedule.
 Example: Holding practice during the summer for leagues that are schedule to play in the fall.
- Using unused practice time after the last day of summer league competition.
- Grouping of practice for summer league to coincide with the start of fall school practice schedule.

Example: Saving unused practices for August 10, 11, 12 and 13th.

- Having the coach, not the league, create the schedule.
- Using school equipment, uniforms or supplies.
- Using the school name or related identification as an outside team moniker.
- Using school facilities for organizational activities, practice or games without following local procedures for non-school user groups.
- Assembling a team roster that is not open to anyone wishing to participate.
- Requiring (direct or implied) participation as a criterion for inclusion on the school team.
- Operating outside of an umbrella organization or formal league such as Parks and Rec. The umbrella organization or formal league is responsible for setting league rules and regulations, league procedures, registering teams and players, creating schedules and setting insurance requirements.
- Participating in a team camp with members of the school coaching staff (Violation of Camp Rule).

Don't gamble. It is much better to ask for permission than plead misunderstanding. Alleged violations brought by member schools or coaches will be investigated by the local superintendent or his/her designee. Those under investigation will be required to supply supporting data.
